This assignment involves you making a somewhat *boring* web page. You are going to be writing the public meeting minutes for the Board of Trustees of the University you used in Assignment 3. The minutes should be laid out in outline format, and you'll need to use nested lists to do this. Additionally, the web page should contain at least one table containing information pertaining to the organization.

This particular page does not have to use colors, font, or styles in general especially well, but, although these minutes are a complete farce, your web page should at least seemingly dispense useful information. And spelling and grammar are **ESPECIALLY** important!

Your webpage needs to be stored in your web folder, along with a menu page or it won't be visible from the web. The menu page needs to be in the top level of your web folder. Your webpage itself should be in a folder called "HW4" in the root of your web folder.

I also need a second copy of it in your CS101-04-20F folder, so that I can grade it and make comments. Create a folder called "HW4" in the root of your CS101-04-20F folder and place a copy of your webpage in that folder. Also place a (possibly empty) file or folder called "DONE" in this folder. When I see the DONE file in your HW4 folder, I will know to grade your assignment. Note: Your file must be called "DONE", exactly. It can't be called "done" or "DONE.txt" or anything like that.

Your menu page needs to be in your web folder, but *NOT* your CS101-04-20F folder.

Your DONE file needs to be in your HW4 folder within your CS101-04-2-F folder, but *NOT* in your web folder.

Your assignment has to be in an HW4 folder in *BOTH* your web folder and your CS101-04-20F folder.
